

if any manipulation, malfeasance, or other suspect activity occurred during any phase of the Election and determine what measures could be taken to prevent conditions that undermine public confidence in our electoral system. Destruction of the records requested by the Petitioner would irreparably harm that effort.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioners, BROWN COUNTY VOTERS FOR ELECTION INTEGRITY, prays that this Court enter an order[s] as follows:

(a). Enter an Order directing the BROWN COUNTY CLERK OF COURT and the BROWN COUNTY ELECTION BOARD to retain all election records from the 2020 general election beyond the 22 months that is legally required by law. We ask that all physical and digital election records be retained for an additional 22 months.

(b). Enter an Order directing the BROWN COUNTY CLERK OF COURT and the BROWN COUNTY ELECTION BOARD to produce and provide Brown County election records by precinct that are commonly referred to as a “Cast Vote Record” (CVR), “ballot log”, or a “summary of ballots”, in a text, comma, or tab delimited file, or a text-based report, listing in the sequence processed by the county, for every ballot, its sequential ID, its timestamp, its method of voting, the specific votes contained for all races, and the batch ID and tabulator ID.

(c) Enter an Order directing the BROWN COUNTY CLERK OF COURT and the BROWN COUNTY ELECTION BOARD to provide the following: 1) the names of all software programs that Brown County uses for election management, 2) the names of all vendors that Brown County works with for election management, e.g. vendors that provide and service the

poll books, the ballot marking devices, the tabulators, the ballots....all vendors that relate to election management; 3) a list of all components of the election system that have wireless capabilities e.g. e-poll books, ballot marking devices, tabulators, servers, etc.; 4) an explanation of the how the wireless capabilities of election equipment are confirmed to be disabled; 5) the name of the person in charge of managing the status of all the wireless capabilities of all election equipment; 6) the name of the person is in charge of verifying the status of the wireless capabilities prior to an election; 7) the documentation that is kept that tracks the verification of the wireless status of election equipment.

(d) For such other and further relief this Court deems just and fair.
